## Tour description

Our tour begins with a journey across the chalk downs of Salisbury Plain and onto the mythical heritage site of Stonehenge and ancient burial sites.

The tour continues at approx. 12noon onto Caen Hill at Devizes for a breathtaking view



and photo opportunity of the 29 lock run (*an engineering marvel completed in 1810*).

From there we move onto Sandy Lane – a small hamlet full of picturesque thatched cottages – for another photo opportunity.

Next stop is Lacock with all its charms (*see Harry Potter's parent's house*). The tour



arrives at approx 1pm and departs at 2.30pm, allowing you to take in the sights and enjoy your lunch.

Our final stop is the beautiful village of Castle Combe before departing for Bristol at 3.30pm
